

2018 CASPR Match Week Placement Status

The AACPM provides periodic status reports on residency placements beginning Match Week through the end of June. The 2018 CASPR Match was released on Tuesday, March 20 at 9:00 AM Eastern. Unmatched applicants and positions participated in a supplemental matching process known as Match Phase Two (MP II). Match Week placement results are being released at 3:00pm Eastern on Friday, March 23.

The following is residency placement data as of March 23, 2018:

When taking overall placements into consideration, 563 (96.1%) of the 586 residency applicants have found residency positions thus far this year. There are 23 (3.9%) applicants that have yet to find a residency position for the 2018-2019 training year.
